The *Project Management Unit – Land Records Management & Information systems* has received¹ a loan² from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development³ in various currencies towards the cost of *LRMIS*. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for supply of Seven Diesel Generators (2-Nos. 100 KVA Diesel Generators and 5-Nos. 60 KVA Diesel Generators) for Three Districts.

2. The *Project Management Unit – Land Records Management & Information systems* now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders, Manufacturers of Diesel Generators or authorized Sales & Service Dealers of the Diesel Generator Manufacturing Companies for the supply of above Seven Number Generators.

3. The supply is divided into two lots as detailed below. The bidders are encouraged to submit their bids for all the lots. However bidders are permitted to bid for one or both the lots depending on their technical, financial and organizational capabilities

4. Bidding shall be conducted through National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans & Credits May 2004 and is open to all eligible bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the bidding document

5. Bidding will be conducted at the office of Project Director, Project Management Unit, Land Records Management and Information Systems Project, 168-Shadman-II, Lahore as defined in the Bidding Document.

9. Sealed Bids must be delivered to the above office⁴ on or before 11.00 a.m on February 28th, 2011 and must be accompanied by a Bid Security of Rs. 70,000/- for Lot-1 and Rs. 1,30,000/- for Lot-2 in the form of Pay Order, Bank Draft or Call Deposit from a Scheduled Bank of Pakistan.
10. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 11.30 a.m in the office of Project Director, Project Management Unit, Land Records Management & Information Systems Project, 168-Shadman-II, Lahore on the same date.
11. The bidders are requested to give their best and final prices as no negotiations are expected.
12. Taxes will be deducted as per GOP Rules. NTN and Sales Tax registration certificate must be provided.
