Subject:- Sale/allotment of residential sites in Chaks/Villages in the rural areas situated within the prohibited zone.

Memorandum:

Under the existing policy instructions issued by the Board of Revenue in its circular memo. No. 2546-80/5057-CLIV, dated 2-11-1981 the allotment of Ihata sites in rural area situated within the prohibited zone is made at the scale of 10 marlas per family. The question under consideration is whether or not the persons holding allotments of residential Ihata sites of more than 10 marlas may be granted proprietary Rights or not. This question has been examined by the Board of Revenue, Punjab and it has been decided that in cases where the allotments had been made prior to 2-11-1981 the question of any fresh allotment would not arise because it is not the intention that old allotment should be revised.

You are requested to proceed further in such cases accordingly.
