



PUBLIC FACILITATION AND IMPROVED SERVICE DELIVERY

E-REGISTRATION OF DEEDS, INTRODUCED IN MAY THIS YEAR

The initiative has successfully caught pace throughout Punjab. The percentage of deeds registered through e-registration has crossed 87% of the total deeds registered since May. The option of appointment of **Local Commission** has also been added to cater to the public need.



ISO Certification

To ensure that the citizens get consistent, fine-quality services, ISO certification for quality management system of Arazi Record Center at Pajian, Raiwand, Lahore has been done as pilot project covering 28 indicators.

Now ISO certification of the other field centers will also be done in phased manner throughout Punjab.

The pre-appointment system has been done away with to allow easy access of land records services to the general public without the hassle of prior appointment.




RANKING OF DISTRICTS ON KPIS

As per direction of SMBR, ranking of districts on 10 KPIs is done on monthly basis and overall categorization is done among the following three categories:

Score	Categorization	
80-100%	Very Good	
60-80%	Good	
Less than 60%	Average	

October, In Jhelum led the rest of the districts on these indicators by securing 'very good' category while Chakwal, Bahawalnagar, RY Khan, Gujrat, and Sahiwal scored the highest score in the 'good' category.



COMPLAINTS REDRESSAL CELL

Over 99% disposal rate

9489 complaints out of 9504 complaints received through different channels (i.e. Whatsapp, UAN helpline, Zameen App, PMDU portal, social media platforms) in the past 9 months have been resolved through the inhouse Complaints Redressal Cell at PLRA.


AUDIT OF 21 ARCS


Financial audit of 21 ARCs has been conducted by Internal Audit teams of PLRA. Missed fees in lieu of Section 236C and 236K (of ITO), Local Govt. (3%), and Tehsil Administration (1%) were identified. After assessment of rebuttals by the concerned staff, Rs. 78 Million amounts of deficiency in fees was finalized by the audit teams, out of which Rs. 31 Million has already been deposited in the Government exchequer.

GIRDAWRI STATUS

E-Girdawri App records onsite data and helps record the latest/updated status of possession and facilitates accurate measuring of season's produce.

E-Girdawri of Kharif has started from 1st October, 2023.






EFFECTIVE MONITORING MECHANISMS

In order to improve the monitoring mechanisms, the following initiatives have been taken: Mutation Pendency Dashboard, Monthly Review Meetings, Internal Audit and field visits.

Mutation Pendency Dashboard: https://dashboard.punjab-zameen.gov.pk/

Mutation Pendency Dashboard has been set up by the IT team that provides up-to-date figures of mutation pendency at ARCs, MARCs, QARCs, and DMMs levels. It also provides pendency of mutations for registered deeds too (registered through e-registration as well as through ROD system).



Field Visits

In order to monitor the working of field offices, Director General PLRA, Ms. Saira Omer, herself as well as other officers have started field visits. In order to make field visits more effective, a detailed proforma has been prepared and duty roster of officers has been prepared to inspect all the field offices in the next three months and report upon the various aspects of working.

Marked reduction in pendency

Pendency of Khewat and Mutation Issues (KMIs) at Arazi Record Centers has substantially reduced due to dedicated monitoring efforts.

CAMPAIGN TO REDUCE PENDENCY OF INHERITANCE MUTATIONS AND PARTITION CASES

As per direction of SMBR, a dedicated campaign has been started to reduce the pendency of inheritance mutations due to pending field reports. Moreover, District Collectors have received clear directions to eliminate backlog by end of this year.



Directions for acceptance of **Succession Certificate** issued by NADRA have been conveyed to the Field Staff on 25th September 2023.



IMPROVEMENTS IN HUMAN RESOURCE

REFRESHER TRAINING OF AROUND 3000 FIELD STAFF (ADLRs, LROs, SCIs, ASCIs, and SCOs) has been conducted throughout Punjab at Division level.

120 SCOS HAVE BEEN ELEVATED TO ASCI (40) AND LRO (80) POSITIONS after competitive selection process and training at MPDD.

<u>HEALTH INSURANCE CARDS</u> have been issued to employees of PLRA covering 10,300 employees and their families with a total coverage of Rs. 3.5 Billion through Pak Qatar Family Takaful Limited (PQFTL).

Digital Land Records and Cadastral Maps for LRMIS

Land for Urban Development Integrated Lan Information System and Services

Project Management and Policy Development

UPDATES

- 102 million pages of old registered deed have been scanned.
- Record of 1,500 mauzas out of 3,042 manual rural urban mauzas has been scanned for Digitization of remaining manual mauzas.
- Mussavis of 18,510 out of 25,446 mouzas have been scanned.
- 55 geodetic monuments in two pilot districts of Hafizabad and Lodhran have been constructed
- Land plots/parcels in 436 housing societies have been converted into digital maps







PULSE has started pilot activities in three districts Hafizabad, Lodhrar and Sahiwal involving digitization of mussavies maps, fieldwork verification and integration with digital records from LRMIS

In Hafizabad, maps of 170 have been developed, while in Lodhran 77 mouzas have been digitized and mapped. The pilot activities of acquisition of drone and satellite imagery have achieved about 45% target in the pilot districts so far.

WAY FORWARD

A SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT WITH MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MOFA) IS UNDER-DISCUSSION AND SOON WILL BE FINALIZED.

The following services will be offered at selected foreign missions in countries having large Pakistani diaspora:

- (i) Copy of record (Fard, mutation, eregistered deed, e-girdawri)
- (ii) Entry and attestation of mutation
- (iii) Registration of deed through eregistration

RS. 757 MILLION APPROVED FOR REVAMPING OF ARCS

PDWP, P&D Board has approved Rs. 757 million for revamping of 151 Arazi Record Centers across Punjab. It covers both revenue and capital components to improve the infrastructure and working conditions of ARCs for better service delivery.

INTEGRATION OF FBR

Consultation with the concerned team of FBR is underway to integrate the FBR fee collection with the PLRA collection mechanism to facilitate the citizens in creation of all the fee challans through PLRA system, thus providing one window facility, proofing revenue leakage, and saving time and hassle.
